

(Papaveraceae)

CALIFORNIA POPPIES

Eschscholzia californica



Botanical name ***Eschscholzia californica*** was given to the plant by a naturalist on an 1816 Russian expedition to California who named it in honor of the ship's surgeon, Dr. Eschscholtz



Botanical name originally included the “t” in the doctor’s name (*Eschscholtzia Californica*).
Recently changed to omit the t.




















